Fair Display Guidelines:

- Students participating in the fair must select a category from their respective age category
- Students must submit their project proposal to FRC by: **October 18, 2019**
- Acceptable Display Mediums include: posters, display boards, sculptures or 3D displays, paintings/drawings, PowerPoint Presentation, Poems (displayed), or Photography.
- All submissions must contain clean language, positive and safe messages- All work including written, recorded or art work must be your own original work and all persons involved must be credited.
- No more than 4 students in a group
- Students are expected to arrive at 9:00am in order to accommodate set up time. Fair will begin promptly at 9:30am.

Step 1:

PLEASE SELECT CATEGORY: AGE 10-12 YRS OLD * You can only participate in one category

- Be a Buddy, Not a Bully**
Identify ways that people can stand up to bullying, safely. This project should display ways in which people can provide support to others who may be experiencing bullying. How can you make a difference by being an “Upstander”? Identify a target population, or choose to address the wider community.
- Bullyproof Your School**
Create an initiative, program, or strategy to help to target the issue of bullying in your school. This project should answer the question: How can you help to ensure that your school is committed to being anti-bullying?
- The Bully Impact**
Present the various impacts of bullying. This project should educate your audience on the impact that bullying has on the victim, the bully, and any other persons who may be affected.

CATEGORY: AGE 13-15 YRS OLD

- Don't Be Mean Behind the Screen**
Present a project on cyberbullying. What is cyberbullying and what are the effects? How can people protect themselves online or on social media and what should you do if you or someone you know is being cyberbullied?
- Bullyproof Your School**
Create an initiative, program, or strategy to help to target the issue of bullying in your school. This project should answer the question: How can you help to ensure that your school is committed to being anti-bullying?
- Don't Bully, Be Caymankind**
Imagine you are assigned an internship with the Cayman Islands Department of Tourism. Create a proposal for a program or initiative that you could implement to contribute to the tourism model of being “CaymanKind”. How can you make sure that our country promotes a culture of kindness, inclusivity, and respect where bullying is not at all tolerated?
